The Winery Train will have trips on: June 27, July 10 & 18, Aug. 1 & 29, Sept. 25 and Oct. 25.

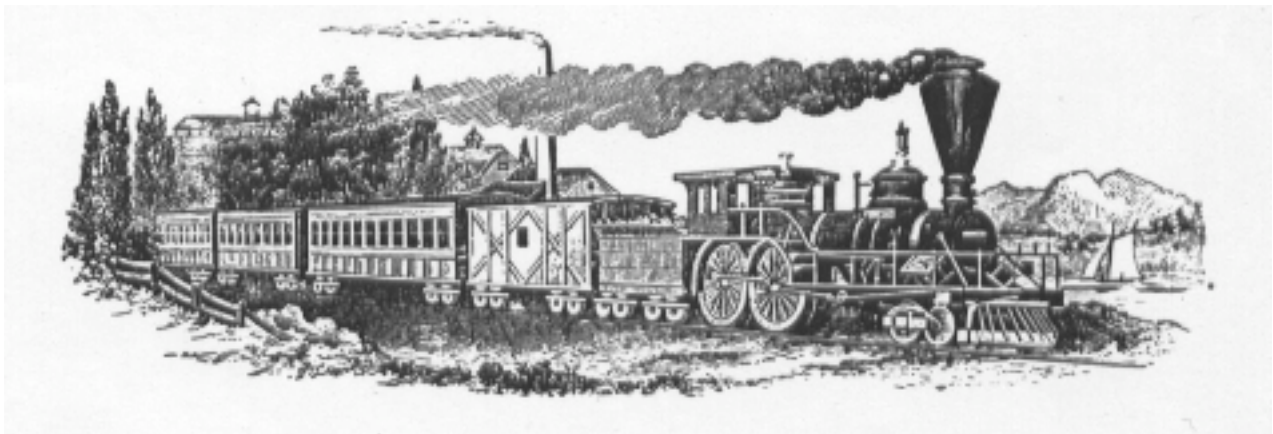
Train Boards: Lockport 10 am (Michigan & Park) Includes:

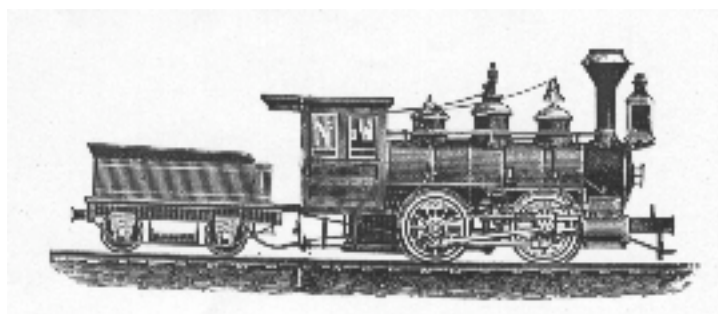
Meeting was adjourned at 8:15 pm.

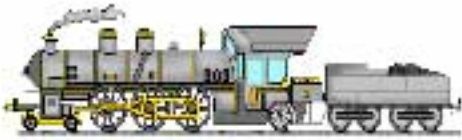


LGB boxcar won by Jimmy Brooks

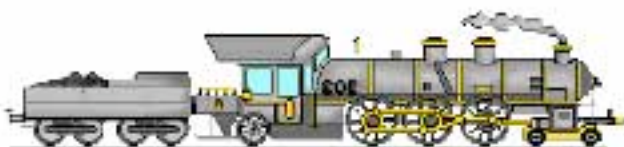
