WNY Garden Railway Society

The more than 40 members of the Western New York Garden Railway Society are hard at work planning the group's Fall Train Display, which will be installed at the McKinley Mall from Friday, November 9 to Sunday, November 18.

If you've been to the society's shows before, or if you've never seen a Garden Railway Society display, you won't want to miss this one. It features a Large G-Scale Model Train layout with steam and diesel engines, some of which are the size of a loaf of bread. They pull cars from all kinds of trains and run on a solid brass track. There is also a trolley line, a tribute to Thomas the Tank Engine, a sawmill scene with an operational log train and a reproduction of an Arcade and Attica train and station. In addition, there will be a raffle for a starter train set.

According to Bob Rodgers, who has been a member of the WNYGRS for 10 years and who has an extensive garden railway in his Orchard Park yard, the mall display requires three days of setup time and is just one of the society's public exhibits. "We also do a layout at the (Erie County) Botanical Gardens from November 26 until the end of the holidays and a show in the Grange Building at the Erie County Fair every summer." Those are in addition to displays at the Depot in Orchard Park and the Central Terminal.

The hours for the WNYGRS Show at the McKinley Mall are Monday through Saturday, 10 a.m.-9 p.m. and Sunday from 9 a.m.-6 p.m. Visit www.wnygrs.com for more information.
